Age Limit

For **NCC candidates** (including wards of Battle Casualties) 19 to 25 years as on 01st April 2019 (born not earlier than 02nd April 1994)

Educational Qualifications

(aa) For NCC 'C' Certificate Holders: Degree of a recognized University or equivalent with aggregate of minimum 50% marks taking into account marks of all the years. Those studying in final year are also allowed to apply provided they have secured minimum 50% aggregate marks in the first two/three years. Such students will need to secure overall aggregate of minimum 50% marks if selected in interview failing which their candidature will be cancelled

The candidate must possess graduation degree at the time of joining training at OTA, Chennai

(ab) Service in NCC: Should have served for minimum two academic years in the senior Division/Wing of NCC

(ac) Grading: Should have obtained minimum of 'B' Grade in 'C' Certificate Exam of NCC

b) For Ward of Battle Casualties of Army Personnel: Degree of a recognized University or equivalent with aggregate of minimum 50% marks taking into account marks of all the years (NCC 'C' certificate not required)

Applicants under category of Wards of Battle Casualties to send their applications direct to Date Gen of Recruiting/ Rtg-A, NCC Entry, West Block-III, R.K. Puram, New Delhi-110066

Eligibility for wards of battle casualties and also document to be attached along with the application form are as under

Physical Standard

- (i) Male Candidates: Height - 157.5 cm
- (ii) Female Candidates: Height -152 cm; Weight - 42 kg

Cut-off in Physical Standards: For candidates belonging to certain categories/ communities or of certain States/Areas; the cut-off in such candidate's Height/ Chest's measurement will be as per Govt. norms. Please see officially released advertisement for more details
