#### Age Limit

For **NCC candidates** (including wards of Battle Casualties) 19 to 25 years as on 01st April 2019 (born not earlier than 02nd April 1994)

#### **Educational Qualifications**

(aa) For NCC 'C' Certificate Holders: Degree of a recognized University or equivalent with aggregate of minimum 50% marks taking into account marks of all the years.
